10 points: questions answered on page 1 for Packet #3

50 points: Composition written neatly on music staff, includes multiple notes for piano, and is written so that anyone who reads music could perform the music

20 points: Packets 1 and 2 completed and turned with final packet

20 points: Composition is performed by the student composer
