Times for students are listed by room and can be found on the band website and in the band room.

Students should arrive approximately 1 hour before their performance time.

When you arrive, you can go to the warm up room to find a place to warm up, take time to find your performance room and check in with the room monitor, and pick up the original music from Mr. Centers (unless you already have your own original copy of the music for the judge).

Dress: Students should dress professionally for their performances. If you are performing in a small ensemble, you can coordinate with the ensemble if you like.

Things to know:

1) **The judge must have an original copy of the music.** Students/groups without an original copy will not receive a score from the judge. If you received music from Mr. Centers, he will have the originals in the cafeteria on the day of the solo and ensemble. If you purchased your own music or a private teacher provided it, you should make certain that you have a copy for you to perform and a copy for the judge. The judge must have an original copy – not a photocopy. You must retrieve the original from the judge and return to Mr. Centers on Saturday.

2) **All measures must be numbered for the judge.** If you are using music from Mr. Centers, you can number the measures any school day in the band room. You may not take the original from the band room.

3) **Judges Score Sheets (Results)** will be picked up by Mr. Centers at approximately 3:45PM. Mr. Centers will return these score sheets to students on Monday. Scores have traditionally been posted at NHHS in past years, but this is not a guarantee.

4) If a student has **conflicting times** (i.e. a solo and an ensemble performing at the same time), they should notify both room monitors and perform with the ensemble first, then make up the time in the solo room by working with the room monitor.

5) If you are pursuing **State Solo and Ensemble:** you must have selected a piece on the state solo and ensemble list. You must list the UIL number on the front of the original music. You must perform the entire selection as listed on the state list with exact instrumentation.

- To qualify for state solo and ensemble, the judge must give a distinguished rating AND recommend you for state. This is noted on the judges sheet.
- Students who qualify for state must pay the state solo and ensemble fee by Monday, May 1. Solo fee \$13; Ensemble fee \$10 plus \$3 per member (duet is \$16, etc.)
- State Solo and Ensemble will be held on Saturday, May 20 at the University of Louisville School of Music
