KMEA Large Ensemble Performance Assessment (formerly known as Concert Festival) is an annual event for KMEA member schools. Four highly qualified judges score the each band on prepared music and sight-reading. Each band is placed in a category based on the level of difficulty of the music selected for the prepared musical selections. Performance at LEPA is also a required performance for all bands wishing to have a competitive marching band in the fall. This is one of our most important performances of each school year.
